Core 4

- Each team <u>must</u> have a minimum of 4 adults on their coaching staff this is known as the Core 4: Head Coach, Assistant Coach, Team Manager, Team Parent.
 - The league covers the cost of registration for the Core 4.
 - A minimum of two members of the Core 4 <u>must</u> be female.
- You are responsible to confirm your Core 4 to your Player Agent by Friday, February 23rd Ask in email to team or at your first team meeting if you have open roles.
- Assistant Coach & Team Parent registration will open today.
- Teams may add additional team staff if desired but must cover the cost. Registration is available on the RGS website.

USA Softball Core 4 Clearance

- RGS will submit Core 4 information to USA Softball. Core 4 will receive an email from USA Softball to complete background checks and SafeSport training.
- All members of the Core 4 must complete Background Check & SafeSport training.
- Coaches who were cleared by USA Softball in Fall 2023 will have their clearance carry over to Spring 2024. You must have your coaches card or re-print from your Homeplate page.
- Uniforms <u>will not be released</u> until your CORE 4 has completed all background checks and SafeSport training.







Coach Conduct

- Code of Conduct Review
 - Every parent & volunteer agreed to this during their registration.
 - Our league is comprised of almost 700 players & 60+ youth umpires. Be a good example to all of them.
 - Think of what is best for the girls.
- 24 Hour Rule
- Coaches are responsible for team members & spectators; this includes a zero-tolerance, no alcohol policy.

 Player agents are the first point of contact and should be notified of any issues including player injuries, gameday issues, and any specific needs of the team.



Team Meeting

Coaches can begin holding team meetings the week of February 5th. These meetings are a good opportunity for the players and families to meet, for you to share your coaching philosophy etc. as well as to:

- Have the players select their team's name (submit via form by February 23)
- Confirm any needed members of the Core 4
- Confirm a need for a team sponsor
- Review Code of Conduct and Operating Policy (Section V: The Spectators)
- Complete Player Emergency Cards
- Have fun!

Youth Umpire Program

RGS has a nationally recognized program for developing and retaining umpires. We are currently in the process of training 60+ umpires for the upcoming year.

RGS provides umpires for all scheduled games, including 6u.

We can cover almost every game internally despite a national umpire shortage. Even high school games are at risk of going unofficiated.

Please remember:

- Just as the players on your team are learning the game, so are the youth umpires.
- Many of our umpires also play in the league and are the daughters of those sitting around you today.



Umpire in Chief (UIC) Update

- The Core 4 must set the expectation and control their spectators in regard to conduct.
- Only a badged female member of Core 4 may communicate with umpires during game time.
- Judgement vs. Rule Interpretation
- Be calm, cool and collected.

Equipment Manager Update

- 6u teams will also receive 2 batting helmets and 2 bats
- 14/16u teams will also receive first aid kits





Field Manager Update

Field Etiquette

- Take pride in the fields we are allocated
- 1st practice drag field before practice
- Last practice drag field after practice
- Make sure equipment boxes are locked
- Chalker and box templates are chained to the fence
- Bases are put away and base pegs are in place

Field Prep

- All teams are responsible to prep/breakdown fields on game days home team is to set up the field and visiting team is to breakdown and clean up the field

Field Manager Update: Inclement Weather Policy

Field conditions are updated by the City of Roseville at 3pm

Reinspect Conditions

Infields are **closed** when:

- Standing/puddles of water
- Your feet are slipping as you walk the infield
- The depth of your footprint is greater than 1 inch

Outfields are closed when:

- Standing water in the grass
- The depth of your footprint is greater than 2 inches
- Your footprints are filling with water after you take a step



Scheduler Update

- Live practice schedule is located online (RGS website)
- Teams may not hold practices on fields or areas that are not allocated to RGS. This jeopardizes our allocations and our insurance. This is also violation of Code of Conduct.
- Once we get final field allocations, we will assign practices by request in a random team order.
- Practice times are for dirt/infield. You can arrive early to warm-up in grass but you will need to stay out of the way of scheduled team.
- There may be times the scheduler has to move your practice or you will be asked to share with another team. Be flexible.
- If you need to change your practice schedule, please email the League Scheduler-scheduler@rosevillegirlssoftball.org
- If you cancel a practice, please email the League Scheduler so we can open it on schedule and/or cancel lights.

Sponsorship Update

General Team Reminders

- Teams cannot fundraise during the season. This includes football squares, bake sales, etc.
- Uniforms may not be altered in anyway, including patches, designation of team captains, etc.
- Teams may not have guest players. If there are not enough players to play a scheduled game,
 you may not "borrow" a player from another team.
- Only badged members of the team staff are allowed on the field and in the dugout during games.
- All teams (10u and up) will need to ensure that you have a scorekeeper for each game. A
 scorekeeping clinic will be held to help families learn how to keep score.
